## Introduction

The Sultanate of Oman Programme for Cultural and Scientific Cooperation involves a cooperation with countries that have a friendly relation with the Sultanate of Oman.

The programme provides grants covering the tuition fees of higher undergraduate studies at certain institutions in Oman for qualified students other countries provided they have been residing in the Sultanate of Oman and completed grade 12 or year 13 at one of the Government or private schools in the Sultanate.

This programme offers scholarships to study at the University of Technology and Applied Sciences, one of the Government higher education institutions.

This guide aims to provide information about the terms & conditions, how to make a competitive application by the relevant deadlines, eligibility criteria and how to accept an offer of a place.

## THE SULTANATE OF OMAN PROGRAMME FOR CULTURAL AND SCIENTIFIC COOPERATION: TERMS & CONDITIONS

- ◆ Be a citizen of the Gulf Cooperation Council countries or one of the countries that have a diplomatic relationship with the Sultanate.
- ◆ Have been residing in the Sultanate for a continuous period of not less than one academic year.
- ◆ Have obtained a general education diploma (**GED**) or its equivalent from an Omani school or an international school in the Sultanate.
- ◆ Have a general education diploma or its equivalent for the current school year 2021 / 2022 (**recent graduate**).
- ◆ Not be older than 25 years old or younger than 16 years by the 1st of October in the current school year and should have been born after 01/10/1997 .
- ◆ Meet the terms & conditions for making a competitive application to the programme as stated in the section comprising courses and criteria.
- ◆ Submit an equivalency certificate issued by the Ministry of Education in the Sultanate in case the student is a holder of an international school qualification.
- ◆ (**If competitively selected**) abide by the rules and regulations in force in the Ministry of Higher Education, Research and Innovation in the Sultanate of Oman.

### Nota Bene

Non-Omani applicants who are born to an Omani mother and a non-Omani father can register and compete in the other programme as Omani applicants.

## ONLINE REGISTRATION: INFORMATION AND SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

### *NON-OMANI STUDENTS STUDYING AT OMAN GOVERNMENT OR PRIVATE BILINGUAL SCHOOLS.*

-The **HEAC** receives information about applicants who graduated from Oman Government and bilingual schools through the Ministry of Education. Therefore, while registering online, they must ensure that their personal details are accurate and up-to-date.

-In the event of any error or update, these applicants should refer to the **The Center of Educational Assessment and Measurement** at the Ministry of Education to make the necessary changes in their personal details.

### *NON-OMANI STUDENTS STUDYING AT INTERNATIONAL (COMMUNITY) SCHOOLS.*

These applicants must provide their personal data and final grades during online registration using the HEAC portal and they must upload the following supporting documents by the relevant deadline.

- 1- A copy of the equivalent certificate for the General Education Diploma. issued by the Ministry of Education for international qualification holders.
- 2-A copy of the school certificate and transcrip.
- 3-A copy of their valid residence (ID) card.

## CALCULATION OF THE COMPETITIVE SCORE (GRADE)

The competitive score is the criterion that defines an applicant position in the list of eligible candidates, based on the average of their achieved grades during the General Education Diploma or equivalent exams, as well as the grades in required subjects. The competitive score of an applicant may vary from one scholarship programme to another depending on their grades in the subjects deemed essential to the course(s) covered by the scholarship.

To calculate your competitive score, use the following criterion as a guideline:

***Competitive score = ( Total sum of grades in required subjects) X 60% or 0.06 + (Total sum of grades of all subjects taken by a student ) X 40% or 0.04***

- In order to register as an applicant with **HEAC**, you have to login to HEAC's website ([www.heac.gov.om](http://www.heac.gov.om)) and create an account by getting a username and password during the period from July 18 - August 18, 2022.
- All applicants must register and select options during the specified period and they have to meet the registration deadline.
- Applicants should check their personal and contact information, such as name, date of birth, gender, national civil number, etc., etc.
- Students have the responsibility to ensure that the personal data **HEAC** processes is accurate.
- If students spot any error(s) with their personal details, they should contact the Directorate *Center of Educational Assessment and Measurement* at the Ministry of Education on one of the following numbers:( **24255745 - 24255837 - 24255753 - 24255755 - 24255752 - 24255754** ).
- Complete your registration by providing all required information and details and make sure that you provide your correct mobile number(s) and e-mail address which would enable **HEAC** to contact you regarding an offer of place.
- It is necessary to provide **HEAC** with your correct mobile number and email address to receive important messages from **HEAC**.
- Higher education institutions and the Ministry of Higher Education, Research and Innovation set the standard requirements or criteria for each scholarship programme.
- You should carefully read these requirements before applying for a specific programme and ensure that you met or are likely to meet the standard requirements for that programme.
- You should rank your programmes in order of personal preference. The **HEAC** system has been designed to competitively shortlist applicants for one of their preferred options.
- You are advised to apply for the maximum number of preferred programmes for which you are deemed eligible, and not just limit your options to scholarship programmes with higher or competitive requirements as this would also limit your chances of being competitively selected for an offer of place by **HEAC's** electronic system.

## ALLOCATION OF PLACES ON SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMMES

- ◆ Upon completion of the registration and entering your options (*programmes*), the *HEAC* system will sort all programmes as per your list of options.
- ◆ Places are allocated and offered to applicants according to the “*order of merit list*”: this means that a number of eligible applicants will be offered the option of their highest personal preference depending on their school grades, admissions requirements, the number of other competitive candidates and the number of available places available for that particular scholarship programme.
- ◆ Applicants who have been offered a place will receive an *SMS* on the mobile number (*they used to register with HEAC*) on the day of the announcement of allocation results. The messages will show the students’ (*Civil ID number*) and the code of the programme for which they have been competitively selected.
- ◆ Please note that *SMS* is a supporting service and the *HEAC* is not responsible in case the student does not receive the message. Student has to check the *HEAC* website to check the programme for which they have been competitively selected.
- ◆ You will be given a period of time to accept or decline the offer (*you have to accept or register during the specified period of time*).
- ◆ If the *HEAC* system does not receive your reply before **02.00** pm (*local time in Oman*) on the last day based on the relevant deadline, you will lose your offer of a place and it will automatically be awarded to another qualified applicant on the waiting list and you will have no right to reclaim the offer of place at any given point in time.

## OFFERS OF A PLACE: COMPLETION OF REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

If you wish to accept an offer of a place, you should complete one of the following two steps:

- 1- You may accept an offer online through **HEAC** website [www.heac.gov.om](http://www.heac.gov.om)
- 2- Alternatively, you may also accept an offer by sending an **SMS** message to (90190) containing the letter (**A**) followed by your **HEAC** number (password).

You will then receive a text message, confirming that your acceptance of your offer of a place has been received. The message will say: “*your acceptance of the offer is successful*”. If you did not receive such message within half an hour after completion of one the abovementioned two steps, then you must visit the **HEAC** website to check if the acceptance of your offer confirmed.

<p><b>OTHER INFORMATION</b></p>	<p><b>Air Ticket Reimbursement:</b> Return air tickets are granted to students once per academic year and it can be compensated and replaced by refund according to the lowest airfare at the time the student submit a requested for a ticket refund. The following students are eligible for air ticket reimbursement: Male and female students studying at the institution in Salalah, but not residing in the Dhofar Governorate. An amount of (25) RO is paid once per academic semester to male and female students from Musandam and Musirah, provided that their family homes are no less than (200) km away from the institution.</p>
